#7 or 8 round brush **OR** a large waterbrush



\*\*This is one of the few projects where a simple palette of 12 colors might be a disadvantage. I would recommend bringing any other bright watercolor paints you have as this project benefits from a LOT of color!

### Supplies I'll Be Using

I used nearly all the bright watercolor pigments on my palette to create my project. I used dark brown (burnt umber) mixed with a burnt sienna and dark blue to get a wide range of browns.

I used the Tombow Fude pen for the line work and then a Faber-Castell for some of the lettering.
